October Tuition

**Accepted payment methods are:
Check, Cash, Payment Processing thru your bank, our business Venmo (@equestrianreserve) or business Zelle (info@equestrianreserve.com). If you pay via Venmo you will need to add the additional fee.**

October Tuition is due at your first lesson of the month to avoid a \$10 late fee and the whole month should be paid in full at that time.

Tuition rates:

- **Full time (weekly) groups/semis \$75/lesson**
- **Less than full time groups/semis \$85/lesson**
- **Full time (weekly) privates \$80/lesson**
- **Less than full time privates \$85/lesson**
- **If you are riding more than once/week or have questions about our sibling/family discount, let us know and we can inform you what your rate is.**

October tuition is below if weekly. Reminder for the school year, we do require makeups for any lessons missed or you forfeit the cost of that lesson. If attending less than weekly, multiply your number of lessons attended by \$85.

- **4 Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays & Fridays @ \$300 for groups/semis or \$320 for privates**
- **5 Saturdays & Sundays @ \$375 for groups/semis or \$400 for privates**
- **4 or 5 Mondays @ \$300 or \$375 for groups/semis or \$320 or \$400 for privates**
 - *We will be open on Halloween, Mon Oct 31, and are planning to hold your lesson. If you will not be in attendance on Halloween or would like to try to get an earlier lesson time that day, please let us know. If you aren't going to attend and would like a makeup lesson, please let us know that as well.*

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: 2023 Horse Show Opportunities

It is time to begin thinking about the 2023 show season. If you are serious about having your rider compete next year at several of the Rolling Hills Saddle Club shows, it is mandatory that you attend one of the informational Parent Meetings held late Nov-early Dec. This is how you begin the process to reserve a desired horse for the season. If your child has not been on our show team, it is mandatory that you attend one of these meetings with your child. Future emails and newsletters will announce the meeting choices of times, and then from there we will select 4 or 5 times that allow everyone to attend one meeting that is convenient for them. If you would like to join our show team for the first time next year, the rider will need to attend a World of Showing Clinic. Dates to be announced later.

In order to be on our Show Team, requirements are that the parent attends the informational meeting, the rider attends the World of Showing Clinic, the rider passes Level I, and you observe one show. If you are planning on showing in 2023 but did not make it to one of our 2022 shows, you will need to plan on observing one of the first 2023 shows in February.

We will have our Annual Show Tack and Show Clothing Sale beginning Dec 1 and it will run through the end of the year.
